MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 12
Series of 2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. C-001, S. OF 2012 REQUIRING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING IN BUENAVISTA, BOHOL TO SECURE A BUSINESS REGISTRATION PLATE AND THE SAME SHOULD BE POSTED AND DISPLAYED IN THE MOST VISIBLE PLACE OF THE BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Buenavista, that:

SECTION 1 – ALTERNATIVE TITLE:

This Ordinance shall otherwise be known as the “Business Registration Plate Requirement in the Municipality of Buenavista”.

SECTION 2 – COVERAGE:

This Ordinance shall cover all type of business establishment registered with the Municipal Treasurer’s Office and shall include all those who will apply for issuance of a Business/Mayor’s Permit from the Municipality after the passage of this ordinance. Any person, natural or juridical that is exempt from paying fees and taxes by virtue of an existing law, rules or regulations shall nevertheless be required to secure the Business Registration Plate and shall be required to pay the fees hereunder provided prior to issuance of the corresponding Business Registration Plate.

SECTION 3 – DEFINITION OF TERMS:

For purpose of proper implementation of this ordinance, the terms hereunder provided shall have the following meaning, to wit:

- a) Business/Mayor's Permit – shall refer to the legal authority granted by the Municipal Government of Buenavista to all person/s (natural or juridical), business establishments, offices, institutions and similar others to operate within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality for a given period of time.
- b) Business Registration Plate – shall refer to the permanent business registration plates which will be issued by the Municipal Treasurer's Office after compliance with all the requirements under existing rules and regulations.
- c) Business Establishment – shall refer to any person, natural or juridical, association, group partnership or organization that is registered with the Office of the Municipal Treasurer and was previously granted an authority to operate within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality. It shall included all other business establishments that will apply for a Business/Mayor's Permit after the passage of this ordinance.
- d) Annual Fees – shall refer to the amount required by the Municipal Treasurer's Office prior to issuance of said business/mayor's permit based on the previous year's gross income and payment computed in accordance with the Municipal Revenue Code of Buenavista, Bohol.
- e) Cost of Registration Plates – shall not be less than the actual expenses incurred by the Municipal Government in the fabrication of the Business Registration Plates. The amount hereunder fixed shall be in addition to the amount computed by the Municipal Treasurer's Office as provided by the Municipal Revenue Code of Buenavista, Bohol.

SECTION 4 – SUPPLY AND DESIGN OF BUSINESS REGISTRATION PLATE/STICKER:

The Municipal Government shall provide the permanent uniform Business Registration Plate and sticker corresponding to the year of issue/renewal to all those who applied and secured a Business/Mayor's Permit in Buenavista, Bohol. The official design of the Business Registration Plate and sticker shall bear the following information, to wit:

A. BUSINESS PLATE DESIGN

- 1) Business Plate Number
- 2) Sticker Box
- 3) Buenavista Official Seal/Logo
- 4) Background design – Municipal Hall & Tourist Spot
- 5) Size – 5 inches x 12 inches
- 6) Signature of the Mayor & Vice Mayor

B. STICKER DESIGN

- 1) Year of Issue
- 2) Signature of the Mayor

SECTION 5 – FEES/CHARGES:

All persons applying for the issuance of a Business/Mayor's Permit shall be required to pay an additional imposition in the amount mentioned-below representing the actual cost incurred by the municipality for the fabrication of the color-coded business registration plates, to wit:

- a) Business Registration Plate – Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00).
- b) Sticker – Fifty Pesos (P50.00), destruction or defaced of the Business Registration Plate, immediate replacement of the same must be initiated by the grantee subject to payment in the amount charge to every new application.

SECTION 6 – ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT:

For the proper enforcement of this Ordinance, the Office of the Municipal Treasurer is tasked to ensure compliance thereof and to make a periodic report to the Office of the Municipal Mayor and if necessary, recommend to the Sangguniang Bayan enactment of certain legislative measures to further improve the implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 7 – PROHIBITED ACTS:

Effective upon approval of this Ordinance, it is hereby declared unauthorized the following acts, to wit:

- 1) Failure to secure or renew the Business Registration Plate prior to its business operation.
- 2) Failure to place the business plate at the area required.
- 3) Unauthorized fabrication of Business Registration Plate and sticker.
- 4) Alteration or destruction of the Business Registration Plate and sticker.
- 5) Utilization of Business Registration Plate of another.

SECTION 8 – PENALTY:

Any act that is found in violation of the foregoing provisions shall have the corresponding penalty.

- 1) **FIRST OFFENSE** – Fine of P500.00
- 2) **SECOND OFFENSE** – Fine of P1,500.00 and/or suspension to operate for a period of fifteen days;
- 3) **THIRD OFFENSE** – Fine of P2,500.00 and revocation of Business Permit.

The penalty imposed under this section shall not bar the Municipality from imposing other penalties provided under existing ordinances, rules and regulations.

SECTION 9 – SEPARABILITY CLAUSE:

If, for any reasons, any part or provisions of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the court, or suspended or revoked by competent authorities, other parts of the provisions thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10 – REPEALING CLAUSE:


Any ordinances, rules and regulations found inconsistent to any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed repealed.

SECTION 11 – EFFECTIVITY:

This ordinance shall take effect after the lapse of ten (10) days from the date of publication in a newspaper of local circulation.
